Attention El Paso County Neighborhood Watch Groups:

The El Paso County Sheriff's Office has recently taken reports of several residential burglaries in your community; specifically in the Kings Deer and Bent Tree subdivisions. Most of these incidents have occurred in the daylight hours, when residents are not home. According to witness reports, the suspects are posing as utility workers and wearing orange colored safety vests. The suspects will arrive at the target residence and attempt to contact the home owners via knocking on the front door. When there is no answer and they discover that no one is home, they then make entry at the rear of the home or through basement windows. The 2 suspects are being described as dark skinned white or hispanic males, approximately 5'10 tall, both in their late twenties or early thirties. They are driving a champagne colored vehicle with a LSU vanity plate on the front. If this vehicle is seen and the rear license plate number is visible, please give this information to the Sheriff's Office. As always, please ensure house and vehicle doors and windows are secured. Please share this information with neighbors and keep watch over each others homes. Report ANY suspicious vehicles or activity to the El Paso County Sheriff's Office.
